 C2	Language skills approaching native fluency It's hard to tell that I'm a non-native speaker.	Competent language use
 C1	Expert language skills I can understand television programmes and films. I rarely search for words when I speak and I can express myself in a clear and structured manner when writing.	
 B2	Independent language use I can follow extended discussions and complex arguments as long as I have some familiarity with the subject. I can make myself reasonably understood.	Independent language use
 B1	Advanced language use I can handle most situations that arise when I travel where the language is spoken. I can explain and justify my opinion and plans.	
 A2	Basic skills I can read short, simple texts and carry on conversations on familiar subjects and activities.	Basic language use
 A1	Beginner If people speak slowly and clearly to me, I can make myself understood in simple sentences.
